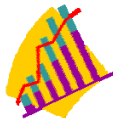

Destiny was still not sure where to go after graduating but knew she liked helping people. SkillSource Trainer, Christy Mataya, encouraged her to sign up for project based learning at Alatheia Riding Center, providing therapy lessons to people with disabilities. She loved the experience. Through this experience she discovered she had a passion for working with children.

This experience gave her the confidence to apply for a Pre-School Teacher's Assistant at ABC Learning Center, where she was hired. Her Trainer provided the support she needed to be successful in her new position; Link Bus Pass, Infant First Aid & CPR Course, and WA STARS on line childcare course, all required for her new position.

Destiny still loves her job and plans to pursue further education to become a Pre-School Teacher in the future.
