*To be considered a family of one, an individual 18-24 residing in the home must have earned at least **\$4077** during the prior six months (30% of \$13,590). See current Youth Eligibility directive for details of 'family of one' and independent/dependent definitions.

**Self sufficiency wage rate is $\$33975/2080 = \16.33 . Minimum wage for underemployed OJT trainees is $\$16.33 \times 90\% = \14.70 .

NOTE: To calculate the LLSIL for family sizes above eight, add the difference between a family of six and a family of five for each family member beyond six (e.g., $\$51,712 - \$44,220 = \$7,492$, which when added to \$51,712 equals \$59,204 for a family of seven, and when added to \$59,204 equals \$66,696 for family of eight, etc., when using 70 percent of the 2022 LLSIL).
