





Employment Trends


As of 2022Q3, total employment for the Moses Lake-Othello, WA CSA was 52,919 (based on a four-quarter moving average). Over the year ending 2022Q3, employment increased 3.4% in the region.


Unemployment Rate

The seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for the Moses Lake-Othello, WA CSA was 6.2% as of December 2022. The regional unemployment rate was higher than the national rate of 3.7%. One year earlier, in December 2021, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in the Moses Lake-Othello, WA CSA was 5.0%.



Wage Trends


The average worker in the Moses Lake-Othello, WA CSA earned annual wages of \$56,194 as of 2022Q3. Average annual wages per worker increased 4.5% in the region over the preceding four quarters. For comparison purposes, annual average wages were \$68,132 in the nation as of 2022Q3.



Annual average wages per worker data are derived from the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages, provided by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and imputed where necessary. Data are updated through 2022Q2 with preliminary estimates updated to 2022Q3.


Cost of Living Index

The Cost of Living Index estimates the relative price levels for consumer goods and services. When applied to wages and salaries, the result is a measure of relative purchasing power. The cost of living is 4.4% lower in Moses Lake-Othello, WA CSA than the U.S. average.



Occupation employment data are estimated via industry employment data and the estimated industry/occupation mix. Industry employment data are derived from the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages, provided by the Bureau of Labor Statistics and currently updated through 2022Q2, imputed where necessary with preliminary estimates updated to 2022Q3. Wages by occupation are as of 2022 provided by the BLS and imputed where necessary. Forecast employment growth uses national projections from the Bureau of Labor Statistics adapted for regional growth patterns.

Education Levels

Expected growth rates for occupations vary by the education and training required. While all employment in the Moses Lake-Othello, WA CSA is projected to grow 1.0% over the next ten years, occupations typically requiring a postgraduate degree are expected to grow 1.3% per year, those requiring a bachelor's degree are forecast to grow 1.0% per year, and occupations typically needing a 2-year degree or certificate are expected to grow 1.1% per year.



Annual Average Projected Job Growth by Training Required

Employment by occupation data are estimates are as of 2022Q3. Education levels of occupations are based on BLS assignments. Forecast employment growth uses national projections from the Bureau of Labor Statistics adapted for regional growth patterns.
