Community Reinvestment

COMING SOON! Local area businesses will soon be able to apply for small business grants *up to \$15,000*. The grants are prioritized for businesses that are Black, Indigenous, or Latino owned or operated. These small business grants are possible through a community reinvestment initiative with the Department of Commerce with the intention to address disparities, strengthen small businesses, grow local talent, and improve local economies. We expect to launch the grant application this summer so stay tuned!

SkillSource utilized community reinvestment funds to sponsor several cultural events in our region, including Cinco de Mayo in Othello, La Terraza de Main Street in Wenatchee, and the Sunflower Festival in Omak in order to help promote this new initiative.





Summer Youth Program


Summer is a fantastic chance for youth to gain work readiness skills! We anticipate an enrollment of 130 youth in our Pre-ETS (pre-employment transition services) summer program. Of the enrolled students, about half will go on to be placed in a paid summer work experience. OFFICIALLY OFFICIAL! As of May 12, after a lengthy three-year litigious obstacle, a registered apprenticeship program became *officially* approved as a post-secondary pathway to qualify for licensure exams as a vet tech thanks to the dedication of Cascade Vet Clinics (CVC) in Wenatchee, East Wenatchee and Leavenworth. Previously, the opportunity to sit for the licensed vet tech certification was only possible after completing a two-year certificate program at a handful of colleges in the state. With registered apprenticeships now clarified as an approved pathway, more qualified candidates will be able to fill veterinary technician and assistant job vacancies and provide essential care to Washington State pets!
